Deposit, Passport & Visa

A non-refundable deposit of \$200 per person is required at the time of registration. Full payment is due before **August 10, 2009**.

Registration forms are available at the ACCGS, 1441 Main Street, Suite 133, Springfield, MA 01103-1449.

Passport and a Chinese travel visa are required. Securing or updating a passport is the traveler's responsibility. Travelers may obtain their own visas, or the Citslinc International will handle the visa application process for a \$145 fee before

August 1, 2009.

ITINERARY

Day 1 ~ Sunday, 11/8/09—New York/Beijing

Board an afternoon flight by 3:30pm to Beijing. Your adventure begins as you fly trans-Pacific aboard a wide cabin jetliner and cross the International Dateline.



Day 2 ~ Monday, 11/9/09—Beijing

Arrive in Beijing, the Capital of China, at 6:00pm. You will be met by your local tour guide at the airport. Transfer to the hotel after dinner.

Day 3 ~ Tuesday, 11/10/09, Beijing

Visit the Tian An Men Square, the largest square in the world, and the Temple of Heaven. Sightseeing includes the Palace Museum, also known as the Forbidden City, and the Summer Palace.



Day 4 ~ Wednesday, 11/11/09, Beijing

Excursion to the Great Wall. The 4,000 mile long and 2,000 year old construction is said to be the only man-made structure visible by naked eye from the moon. Visit the Ming Tombs before dining on a Roasted Beijing Duck Dinner.

Day 5 ~ Thursday, 11/12/09, Beijing/Shanghai/Suzhou

Spend the morning in Beijing and the afternoon sightseeing in Shanghai and Suzhou to including the Linger Garden, Tiger Hill, Hanshan Temple, and the National Embroidery Institute. Enjoy an evening dinner show with traditional Chinese music.



Day 6 ~ Friday, 11/13/09, Suzhou/Hangzhou

Morning tour bus journey to Hangzhou to visit the Economic Development Zone and the centuries old Lingyin Temple.

Day 7 ~ Saturday, 11/14/09, Hangzhou/Shanghai

Morning boat cruise on West Lake with relaxing stopover at jewel-like pagodas and tea houses. Afternoon tour bus trip to Shanghai.



Day 8 ~ Sunday, 11/15/09, Shanghai

Sightseeing includes the Yu Garden, a maze of marvelous pavilions, ponds, rocky works and over-arching trees. Visit the Bund, a famous waterfront park. Business visits to the Pudong Economic Development Zone.

Day 9 ~ Monday, 11/16/09, Shanghai/Beijing/New York

Morning flight to Beijing from Shanghai. Afternoon flight will depart by 1:00pm for JFK.
